3 ACTS OF KINDNESS PROJECT DUE BY Wednesday, January 9th

December's character trait is Kindness and in the spirit of the Holiday Season each student is responsible for brainstorming ideas about different acts of kindness. The Kindness Acts should be things your child does over the Winter Break.

Your child has been given a sheet of construction paper. We have made 8 separate rectangles by folding. Each Kindness Act will require two rectangles. The student must write at least four sentences in each of the Kindness Acts rectangles and create a colored illustration to go along with it in the rectangle next it. In each Kindness Act description, the student needs to include Who was helped, What was done, Where/When it was done, and Why did the student decide to do this (written in any order but as a paragraph).

The Impact rectangle should be a 4-6 sentence summary of what the student learned from the experience. This should **not** start with "I learned..."

This is a Social Studies and Writing Grade. Students will have a chance to share their 3 Acts of Kindness to the class after the Winter Break.
